Living in Truth, Living in Freedom



John 8:31-59

<u>Jesus' Claim:</u>

"If you continue in my word, you really are my disciples. You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31-32)

- Continue (Remain, abide. See John 15:1-8)
- Truth
- Freedom

What you believe is true will determine how you live. It will either lead to life or to destruction.

Jesus' Truth sets you free to see yourself rightly (John 8:33-38):

How are you experiencing Jesus' Truth leading you to freedom?

Which of the points about Jesus' freedom resonates with you most currently? Why?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-56; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5; and Ephesians 6:10-20. Discuss how these verses relate to what Jesus says in this conversation, particularly in John 8:44-47, and how you can apply them to your life.

As we think about our mission of making God's love known, how does this passage equip you to live out the Truths of Jesus where you live, work, learn, and play?

<u>Pray:</u>

Pray for one another based on your discussion. Pray for those in your life who are near to you relationally but far from Jesus.
