MAY SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION: PSALM 139:1-6, 23-24

This week focus on meditating on and memorizing Psalm 139:1-2 (NLT): O Lord, you have examined my heart and know everything about me. You know when I sit down or stand up. You know my thoughts even when I'm far away.

MAY SPIRITUAL PRACTICE: LISTENING

As believers in Christ, we know that God loves us (John 3:16). One way He demonstrates His love for us is His desire to communicate with us -- personally. Not only does He listen to our prayers to Him (Ps. 34:17, James 5:16), but He converses with us as well. He not only communicates to us as we read through the Scriptures, but He speaks directly to us by the Holy Spirit. The wonderful truth is He equips us to hear His voice! "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me" (John 10:27). "Whoever is of God hears the words of God" (John 8:47a). "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me" (Rev. 3:20).

This month we will focus on the practice of growing in our ability to hear God personally and directly. We will explore what, where, and how God speaks. As we prepare to practice listening, we need to remove any hindrance to our ability to hear His loving direction and affirmation. Ask the Lord to show you any areas of your life that need to be surrendered to Him: unrepentant sin, unforgiveness, fear, or unbelief. Confess these to Him and receive His grace and forgiveness.
